ENGINEERING UPDATES

### Hershey Road Pump Station:

- We received BIU approval and CT is preparing to advertise for bids.
- Grant dollars have been awarded.

### **Construction Projects:**

- All planned waterline projects are in the process of being surveyed.
- We are coordinating with the contractor to install the Robison Road Pressure Reducing Valve Assembly. Parts are ordered and should be in within a couple of weeks.
- The Authority should hear if approved for the PA Small Water and Sewer Grant to be allocated to the Hershey Road Waterline Replacement Project by January 2026.

#### Administrative:

• Act 57 Tapping Fees are being updated.

Manager Hiles informed the Board the Arsenic Tanks at Moore Road need cleaned out as they have been sitting unused for 5 years. We also need to repair the gas well since it is leaking and the pipes are starting to rot.

MOORE ROAD MAINTENANCE

The Authority will be searching for someone to replace a field employee who plans to retire in 2 years. We need to start now because it takes 2 years to become a licensed operator.
